Pre-fabrication and pre-assembly enables us to deliver mechanical systems, components and materials for immediate installation according to schedule, unhindered by uncontrollable job site conditions such as rain, extreme heat or cold, and potential damage or theft of system components. The process eliminates the significant amount of material handling on site, and helps to guarantee safety, consistent quality, greater efficiency and standardization in construction.

Major Community Service Initiatives

James A. Michener Art Museum

The Company, which raised approximately \$8000 for the event, was honored as having the "Best Decorated Campsite". Last year Worth & Company was named "Rookie of the Year" by the American Cancer Society, which gives the award to a *Relay for Life* newcomer that makes an outstanding inaugural year contribution.

Rebuilding Together Philadelphia

Worth & Company has been a long-time supporter of Rebuilding Together Philadelphia, an organization that helps 50 homeowners each year, primarily in north and west Philadelphia and Norristown to rebuild the region's most fragile neighborhoods. The company donates both time and materials to the "*Spring Blitz*." Each year in March and April, 1,000 skilled and general volunteers spend approximately 3-4 weeks alongside the homeowners and their families to make essential home repairs.

Tsunami Relief
